


Appendix B



Hasty Tourniquet

<u>Conditions:</u> While in a combat environment, you encounter a casualty with life-threatening bleeding from an extremity. You have your individual personal protective equipment (PPE) and your casualty's improved first aid kit (IFAK).

Standards: Perform care under fire following the correct sequence without exposing yourself to unnecessary enemy fire.

Required equipment and supplies: ballistic helmet, individual body armor, a writing instrument, a fully stocked improved first aid kit (IFAK), and rescue randy manikin or leg assembly.

1. Pull the free end of the self-adhering band through the buckle and route through the				
friction adapter buckle.				
2. Slide the injured limb through the loop formed by the Combat Application Tourniquet				
and place as high as possible, over the clothing				
3. Pull the band tight around the limb and fasten it back on itself as tightly as possible				
4. Twist the windlass until the bleeding stops.				
5. Lock the windlass in place within the windlass clip.				
6. Secure the windlass with the windlass strap.
